ABOUT THE CLASS

The course consists of on-demand preparatory study, in-person preparatory study (4 FEB), and fieldwork in Fukushima (5 FEB-7 FEB).

Fukushima is a place that suffered tremendous damage from the earthquake, tsunami, and nuclear accident 13 years ago. While the locals are actively going about their daily lives, there are still issues related to the incident that need to be resolved. In this field work class, the students will travel to Fukushima and learn from local residents by working with them on farms and conducting interviews. As a result, students create magazine articles based on their experiences and interviews. The magazine article would be shared with the students in the US who are interested in and studying about the Fukushima issue.
